	Council position  Pete confirmed the current cleaning schedule: 1 operative regularly cleans the centre 5 days a week (7am – 3pm). Weekends team of 2 for whole borough concentrating on centres only.	
	Due to the current financial position, there is no money available to	

	provide more bins. However, street cleansing can approach local businesses asking them to sponsor a bin.	
	The Council would be able to provide support for the event including:	
	<ul><li>Loan of litter pickers</li><li>provision of disposable gloves</li><li>provision of plastic bags for the collected rubbish</li></ul>	
	Environmental Health 'duty of care' enforcement on local businesses for their waste removal. They also went into local schools with preventative education on litter. However, due to cuts, these services are limited	
	<b>Action:</b> Pete approach local businesses (Greggs, Pound Bakery etc.)	Pete
	<b>Action:</b> Pete Burns to leave kits with Rob for the Drinkwater and Buckley Lane groups	Pete
	<b>Action:</b> Rob to scout pick up points and liaise with Pete Burns. Possible collections 2pm on the Sunday, later collections to be collected Monday morning.	Rob
	Forestry Commission Blue Sky are contracted by Forestry Commission to clean their areas. If notified of specific problem areas, Forestry Commission can contact Blue Sky to remove.	
	<b>Action:</b> Forestry Commission to look at appropriate signage so members of the public can ring them direct regarding issues.	Forestry Comm

	It was agreed to concentrate on three main areas: Drinkwater (led by Rob), Buckley Lane (led by Radek) and Church Lane (led by Mike).	
	Suggested approach local business regarding refreshments on the day for volunteers. Concerns with timing of event may be too short notice.	
	Action: Rob to approach local businesses	Rob
	<b>Action:</b> Before and after pictures required for promotional purposes. Volunteer required.	ALL
	Action: Mike to compile press release post event.	Mike
	<b>Post meeting note:</b> Suggestion from Mike - it would be a really good idea to stagger the time of the events. However, subsequently we agreed that this does not work well due to the amount of litter	


expected to be picked up and the distance between each of the 3 clean up events. As such all events will start at 10 am on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> March 2017.


